SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to S.P. 772,
L.D. 2209, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution
to Limit the Amount of Government Spending and Taxes which may
be Made without Voter Approval.

Amend the amendment by striking out in the 6th paragraph,
all of paragraph C and inserting in its place the following:

'C. The Legislature declares an emergency by a two-thirds
vote prior to incurring any of the expenses which constitute
the emergency request.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would permit the Legislature to use its
discretion in acting upon the emergency.
