SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to S. P. 772, L.D. 2209, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Limit the Amount of Government Spending and Taxes which may be Made without Voter Approval.

Amend the Amendment on Page 3 by striking out in the next to the last line of the first paragraph the underlined words "any personal" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'any existing personal'

Further amend the Amendment on Page 3 by striking out all of the last 4 lines and inserting in their place the following:

'(10) Expenditures from existing dedicated revenue accounts
for the programs and services in effect on the effective
date of this amendment, or expenditures of the proceeds of
taxes on owners of products or resources used to promote
or protect such products and resources.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last 2 paragraphs before the statement of fact and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the Resolution by striking out all of the last 3 paragraphs before the constitutional referendum procedure.'
