HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\widehat{A}$ " to H.P. 2336, L.D. 2210, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Establish Property Tax Exemptions for Maine Homesteads.

Amend the Resolution by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in its place the following underlined sentence:

'The exemption shall not be less than \$5,000 of just value and the rebate shall not be less than \$25.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the homestead exemption from \$20,000 to \$5,000.
