Tax Exemptions for Maine Homesteads.


Amend the Resolution by striking out all of the 2nd
underlined sentence of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in its
place the following underlined sentence:

'The exemption shall not be less than \$5,000 of just value and
the rebate shall not be less than \$50.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the homestead
exemption from \$20,000 to \$5,000 and to change the renters
rebate from \$100 to \$50.
