HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to Joint Order, H.P. 12

Amend the Joint Order in that part designated "13."
in the last paragraph by striking out all of the 4th sentence
and inserting in its place the following:

'The Senate chairman shall preside at the first meeting of the
committee; the House chairman shall preside at the second meeting
of the committee and thereafter, at successive meetings of the
committee, the presiding officer shall be alternately the
Senate chairman and then the House chairman. If the chairman
scheduled to preside at a particular meeting is absent the
chairman of the other House shall preside, and in the absence
of both the Senate chairman and the House chairman, the
chairmanship shall alternate between the members from each House
in the order of their appointment to the committee.'
