Amend the Order by striking out all of the 5th paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Ordered, the Senate concurring, subject to the Legislative
Council's review and determination hereinafter provided,
that a select committee be appointed consisting of 3 members
of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Institutional
Services, 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on
Appropriations and Financial Affairs and 2 members of the
to
Joint standing Committee on Education be appointed by the
President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives
jointly. The committee shall elect a chairman who shall serve
at the pleasure of the committee; and be it further

Ordered, that the committee study the problem of alcoholism and alcohol abuse and methods of treatment and rehabilitation in education, including the client-oriented system; and be it further!
