SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 42, L.D. 28, Bill, "AN ACT to Test an Open Season on Moose for a One-year Period."

Amend the Amendment by inserting at the end of subsection

10 of that part designated "§2355-F." the following underlined blocked paragraph:

'The commissioner shall use at least 1/2, or \$85,000, whichever is smaller, of the revenue generated by moose permits and application fees for moose research and management.'

This amendment provides that a portion of the revenue generated by the experimental moose season is used for moose research and management.
