COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 13, L.D. 30, Eill, "AN ACT to Require that Reading be Taught in all Schools in Grades 1 through 12."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §102, sub-§7, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1969, c. 234, §1, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentences:

A course in reading shall be taught to all pupils in grades 1

to -> 8 in all public or private school systems. A course in

remedial or developmental reading shall be offered to any pupil

in grade 9 to -> 12 in all public or private schools if need

is demonstrated.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

- Require that all pupils are taught reading in grades
 to 8; and
- 2. Require that any pupil needing remedial or developmental reading in grades 9 to 12 shall be offered this course.
