### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Require that Reading be Taught in all Schools in Grades 1 through 12.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 102, sub-§ 7, first  $\P$ , as last amended by PL 1969, c. 234, § 1, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

A course in reading shall be taught in each grade from 1 to 12 in all school systems, both public and private.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make reading a required subject in every grade, 1 through 12.
