HOUSE AMENDMENT " " to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 18,
L.D. 35, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit the Publication of the Names of
Juveniles in Connection with Arrests and Court Appearances."

Amend the Amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 by adding at the end after the underlined word "effect" the following:

', except that records of those juvenile offenders who have been convicted 2 or more times within a one-year period of a crime injurious to persons or property

## shall be open to inspection by the general public'

Further amend the Amendment in section 2 in subsection 4 by adding at the end after the word "studies" the following:

', except that records of those juvenile offenders who have been convicted 2 or more times within a one-year period of a crime injurious to persons or property

shall include the names of the juvenile, his parents, quardian, legal custodian, his attorney or any other parties and may be inspected by persons having a legitimate interest in the proceedings or by persons conducting pertinent research studies including legitimate members of the news media'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment allows names of juvenile offenders who are convicted of crimes injurious to persons or property 2 or more times within a one-year period to be exposed for the good of the general public.
