SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 24, L.D. 41, Bill, "AN ACT to Remove Restrictions on Eligibility under the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act based on Marital Status."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 1st paragraph the following:

Further amend the bill by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

2. Disabled. Be currently not married and have attained the age of 55 during the year for which relief is requested and shall, due to a disability, be receiving federal disability payments, such as supplemental security income.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out the amount "\$800,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$60,000'

Fiscal Note

This bill, as amended, will require an appropriation of \$60,000 for fiscal year 1980-81.

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the expansion of the original bill to people not currently married. This amendment also adds a new fiscal note and appropriation to the bill.
