COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 24, L.D. 41, Bill,
"AN ACT to Remove Restrictions on Eligibility under the Elderly
Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act based on Marital Status."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement
of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of
this Act.

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective
with regard to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 1980.'

This bill, as amended, will require an appropriation of
\$800,000 for fiscal year 1980-81.

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an effective date of January 1, 1980,
an appropriation and a fiscal note to the bill.
