HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 26, L.D. 43, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage to \$4 Per Hour."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the title the figure "\$4" and inserting in its place the figure '\$3.50'

Further amend the Bill by striking out in the 8th and 12th lines (7th and 10th in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$4" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$3.50'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish the state minimum wage at \$3.50 per hour.
