SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 26, L.D. 43, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Minimum Wage to \$4 Per Hour."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Establish the Minimum Wage at \$2.90 Per Hour and to Set a \$4 Per Hour Ceiling.'

Further amend the Bill in the 8th and 12 lines (7th and 10th lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "<u>\$4</u>" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$2.90'

Further amend the Bill in the last 2 lines before the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) by striking out the stricken out punctuation, words and figure "7-but-in-no-case-shall-the-minimum-wage-exceed \$3-per-hour" and inserting in their place the following: ', but in no case shall the minimum wage exceed \$3 \$4 per hour'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to establish the minimum wage at \$2.90 per hour and to set a \$4 per hour ceiling to which that minimum wage may rise in response to increases in the federal minimum wage.
