AN ACT to Appropriate \$25,000 to Lay Advocates at Work, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Lay Advocates at Work, Inc.; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Lay Advocates at Work, Inc., of Freeport, Maine the sum of \$25,000 for fiscal year 1979-1980. These funds shall be used to maintain an office and necessary staff to carry out a program of assistance to persons with justified complaints against attorneys in pursuing those complaints before the appropriate forums.
