# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Concerning the Crime of Prostitution.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17-A MRSA  $\S$  853-A, sub- $\S$  1, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 499,  $\S$  1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

- 1. A person is guilty of engaging in prostitution if he:
- A. Engages in prostitution as defined in section 851; or
- B. Gives, offers or promises a pecuniary benefit to another person in return for the other person or a 3rd person engaging in, or agreeing to engage in, sexual intercourse or a sexual act, as defined in section 251.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make the person who solicits prostitution equally as quilty as the person who engages in it.
