COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 78, L.D. 86, Bill, "AN  
ACT to Establish a Bounty on Coyote."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the  
Statement of Fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

Additional cost to the Department of Inland Fisheries and  
Wildlife for this bounty is estimated from \$25,000 to \$75,000  
per year.

The estimated coyote take for this current season is 500,  
which would cost \$25,000. It is felt that Canadian coyotes and  
coyotes from other states would be redeemed, thus the upper  
estimate of \$75,000 each year.'
