COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 33, L.D. 100, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Permissible State Discount to State Agency Stores to 12% Under the Alcoholic Beverages Statutes."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Concerning the Price of Liquor Sold by a Special Agency Store.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'28 MRSA §157 is enacted to read:

§157. Agency liquor prices

A special agency store may price spirituous and vinous liquor, except table wine, at a price 3% more than the retail price established for state retail stores.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow special agency stores to sell some of their liquor products, everything except beer and table wine, at a price 3% higher than that charged at a state liquor store.
