SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 114, L.D. 123, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Motorcycle Operators and Passengers and Motor Driven Cycle Operators and Passengers to Wear Helmets if they are Minors."

Amend the Bill in the Title by inserting after the words "Wear Helmets" the words 'or Have Helmets Available'

Further amend the Bill by inserting after the underlined words "shall wear" in the 3rd line from the end before the statement of fact the following underlined words 'or have available on the motorcycle or motor driven cycle'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires that the/subject to the bill must either wear a helmet or have a helmet available on the motorcycle or motor driven cycle.
