COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 128, L.D. 133, Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Sardine Tax Law."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §4152, first sentence is amended to read:

The Commissioner of Agriculture after such consultation with members of the industry as he regards desirable shall appoint not more than 9 nor less than 7 practical sardine packers as defined in Title 36, section 4693 to a board to be known as the Sardine Industry Advisory Board.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §4692, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1975, c. 656, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 5 to be sections 3 to 6.

Statement of Fact

This amendment increases the possible size of the Sardine Industry Advisory Board to equal the increase in the size of the Maine Sardine Council.
