COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 125, L.D. 135, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase Fees and Mileage Reimbursements of
Witnesses."

Amend the Bill in the Title by striking out the words "Fees and"

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Witnesses, other than members of the State Police or municipal police officers, in the Supreme Judicial Court, the Superior Court, the District Court or in the probate court, unless the court shall otherwise order, shall receive \$10, and before referees, auditors or commissioners specially appointed to take testimony or special commissioners on disputed claims appointed by probate courts, \$10, or before the county commissioners, \$10 for each day's attendance and \$10\noting-a-mile-for-each-mile's-travel-going-and-returning-home their actual travel expenses including mileage at the same rate as state employees under Title 5, section 8.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
