Officers and the State Auditor by \$5,000."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §7, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by
PL 1977, c. 697, §3, is amended to read:

1. Secretary of State, State Auditor and Treasurer of State
Notwithstanding section 6 or
any other provision of law, the respective salaries of the
~~Attorney-General~~; Secretary of State, State Auditor and
Treasurer of State shall be as follows:

- ~~A. Attorney-General.....\$257,000~~
- B. Secretary of State.....\$207,000 \$25,000;
- C. State Auditor.....\$207,000 \$25,000;
- D. Treasurer of State.....\$187,000 \$25,000;

Sec. 2. 2 MRSA §7, sub-§3, is enacted to read:

3. Attorney General. Notwithstanding section 6 or any
other provision of law, the salary of the Attorney General shall
be the same as that of an Associate Justice of the Supreme
Judicial Court.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
