SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 131, L.D. 142, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Constitutional Officers and the State Auditor by \$5,000."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the title the word and figure "by \$5,000"

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out in the first line after the amending clause the underlined figure "<u>\$30,500</u>" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$32,500'

Further amend the Bill by striking out in the last line before the emergency clause the underlined figure "23,000" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure

The Executive Branch, recognizing the present corrosive rate of inflation, has consistently increased the salaries of its department heads in order to attract and keep good amendment people in departmental positions. This / evenhandedly applies that policy to the officers elected by the Legislature.
