STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning County Commissioners' Discretionary Powers Regarding Grants Placed in County Budgets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 253-B, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 654, § 1 is amended to read:

\S 253-B. Certain grants to be paid on a quarterly basis

Any grants placed in the county budget by the Legislature to any agency outside of the regular county departments must may be paid to such agencies on a quarterly basis.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to give discretionary powers in regard to the payment of grants to agencies on a quarterly basis. Under the current statute, county commissioners are mandated to pay on a quarterly basis.
