COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 78, L.D. 167, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Campaign Finance Law."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'Although the commission mails the forms for required reports, failure to receive forms by mail does not excuse committees, candidates and other persons who must file reports from obtaining the forms.'

Further amend the Bill in section 4 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'Although the commission mails the forms for required reports, failure to receive forms by mail does not excuse persons required to file reports from/otherwise obtaining the forms.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes provisions in the bill consistent with present practice but clarifies that candidates or other persons who must file shall not be excused from obtaining forms by failure to receive forms in the mail.
