COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 93, L.D. 179, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Representation of Towns on Community School Districts."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'If any representative on the school committee is absent from 3 consecutive committee meetings, the committee may declare that a vacancy exists and the school committee of the representative's town may choose from among its members another representative to the community school committee.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for the replacement of a community school committee representative when the representative has been absent from 3 consecutive committee meetings.
