HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 93, L.D. 179, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Representation of Towns on Community
School Districts."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'- If a representative from a town is absent from a meeting, then the town which he represents shall be represented at that meeting by one of the remaining members of the town's school committee, who is not a member of the community school committee. He shall be chosen on the basis of seniority.

If all of the members of town's school committee are members of the community school committee, then the other representatives from the town on the community school committee shall fulfill the duties and responsibilities of the absent member at that meeting.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a town's continuous representation on a community school committee whenever a representative from the town is absent.
