/ AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 174, L.D. 208, Bill,

"AN ACT to Prohibit the Gathering of Signatures Within 250 Feet of the Entrance to a Polling Place and Within any Registrar's Office."

Amend the Bill in the title by striking out the words "and Within any Registrar's Office"

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'21 MRSA §892, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Signature solicitation prohibited. Soliciting signatures for any petition on election day outside of a polling place within 250 feet of the entrance is prohibited.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment prohibits soliciting for any petition outside a polling place within 250 feet of the entrance. The section of the bill which restricted soliciting within a registrar's office is deleted.
