AN ACT Authorizing the City of Portland to Lease to the State its Central Fire Station Presently Located on Land Known as Lincoln Park Extension for Court Use and for the Administration of a Court System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P&SL 1923, c. 82 is amended by adding at the end the following:

The City of Portland authorized to lease fire station to the State of Maine. The City of Portland is authorized and empowered to lease its Central Fire Station now located upon Lincoln Park Extension, that lot of land in the city bounded by Pearl, Market, Federal and Congress Streets, to the State of Maine upon such terms and conditions as it may deem appropriate for the purpose of use for courts and the administration of court systems and any other activity necessary thereto. Furthermore, the city may make such future additions to the structure or any changes or repairs that it deems necessary in the furtherance of the purpose stated herein. This authority is granted notwithstanding that Lincoln Park Extension was originally taken for and dedicated to park purposes and shall be in addition to the authority granted in this chapter.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the City of Portland to lease its Central Fire Station located on Lincoln Park Extension to the State of Maine for use in its district court system.
