STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Remove the Sunset Provision on the Tort Claims Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

PL 1977, c. 2, \S 5, first \P , 2nd sentence, as amended by PL 1977, c. 591, \S 6, is repealed as follows:

This Act shall remain effective until November 1, 1979

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the sunset provision on the Tort Claims Act that would effectively repeal the Act on November 1, 1979.
