STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning Raccoon Damage to Crops and Livestock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2365 is enacted to read:

§ 2365. Raccoons

There shall be a perpetual open season for the hunting and trapping of raccoons in the town of Deer Isle, located in Hancock County. The provisions of this section shall remain in effect until January 1, 1983.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Many people in the Deer Isle area have been having problems with raccoons ruining their gardens and killing poultry. This bill provides for a 3-year open season on raccoons to control this problem.
