COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 199, L.D. 248, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing Additional Funds to Acquire Land for a Passenger
Terminal, Transfer Bridge and a Parking Area for the Casco
Bay Ferry Service in Portland and to Provide Funds for their
Construction."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out at the
beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and
figure "Sec. 2."

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to remove the \$360,000
appropriation for improvements to Portland waterfront facilities
and to provide that previous funds appropriated for this purpose
will not lapse but will be carried forward to be expended for
the improvements when they take place.

Since the federal funds have not yet been made available
to the City of Portland and since the site for the new pier and
terminal have not been selected, the appropriation has been
removed.
