AN ACT to Increase the Stipend for the County Law Library at Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

27 MRSA § 224, 10th ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 120, is amended to read:

Oxford, \$3,000 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at South Paris and ~~\$3,500~~ \$4,500 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at Rumford;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the state stipend for the county law library at Rumford from \$3,500 to \$4,500. There has been no increase in the stipend for several years, despite the recent increases in the cost of law books. This bill provides for that much needed increase.
