STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Mandatory Shoreland Zoning Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 4813, first ¶, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 468, § 1, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The repeal of Title 12, section 4813, first paragraph, last sentence, would clarify the Legislature's intent that the Board of Environmental Protection and the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission have a continuing responsibility to insure that municipalities do not repeal previously enacted shoreland zoning ordinances or otherwise fail to meet the requirements of the Act after January 1, 1976.
