**AN ACT to Prohibit Regulation of Solar Heating and Cooling Equipment by the Oil  
Burner Men's Licensing Board.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 2302, sub-§ 5 is enacted to read:

5. **Solar heating and cooling.** Any heating or cooling equipment operated by means of solar energy.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent regulation of solar energy heating and cooling equipment by the Oil Burner Men's Licensing Board.
