SENATE AMENDMENT"B"to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to H.P. 250, L.D. 295, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Constables and Special Police Officers."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the last 5 lines before the statement of fact and inserting in their place the following:

'A constable's certificate of appointment shall state whether or not he is allowed to carry a weapon, concealed or unconcealed, in the performance of his duties. Any limitation regarding the use of a weapon shall only apply at those times when the constable is performing his duties.'
