COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 301, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for an Advisory Referendum of Reducing the Number of Members of the Maine House of Representatives from 151 to 99 Members."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Special advisory referendum on the size of the Maine House of Representatives. The Secretary of State shall, at the special statewide election on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November following the passage of this Act, hold a special advisory referendum to determine the sentiment of the people on whether or not the Maine House of Representatives should be reduced in size from 151 to 99 members.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'"Shall the size of the Maine House of Representatives be reduced from 151 to 99 members?"'

The purpose of this amendment is to / delete the question of Legislator's pay from the advisory referendum.
