COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 151, L. D. 328, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Amend the Workers' Compensation Statute to Provide  
for Podiatric Services."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending  
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'An employee sustaining personal injury arising out of  
and in the course of his employment, provided the injury relates  
to the foot, shall be entitled to an examination, diagnosis and  
treatment therefor from a podiatrist who is licensed in the  
State of Maine and who has been granted the degree of Doctor  
of Podiatric Medicine by an accredited school of podiatry  
recognized by the Council of Education of the American Podiatry  
Association. This examination may include diagnostic x-rays.  
Such a podiatrist is competent to testify before the Workers'  
Compensation Commission.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure that the bill  
refers to fully qualified doctors of podiatric medicine
