COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to S.P. 152, L.D. 329, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Telecommunications for the Deaf."

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following: $'\underline{Sec.\ 1}.'$

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end, before the emergency clause, the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
