AN ACT Relating to Weight Imparted by Tire Width of Tires on Certain Farm Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 1652, sub-§ 2, ¶ C, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 237, § 4, is amended to read:

C. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Title, no vehicle shall be operated or caused to be operated when the load imparted to the road surface is greater than 600 pounds per inch width tire, manufacturer's rating, **excepting farm trucks transporting agriculture products.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow agriculture trucks hauling fresh products from their fields to be exempt from the 600 pound per inch tire width requirement.
