COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 270, L.D. 344, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Licenses Issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife."

Amend the bill in section 4, in that part designated "§2851," by adding at the end of subsection 1 the following new paragraph:

'No person may breed, rear or keep alive any wild animal taken in accordance with section 2354'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will prohibit persons from taking nuisance animals and breeding or rearing them to sell their pelts.
