HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 270, L.D. 344, Bill, "AN ACT
Concerning Licenses Issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries
and Wildlife."

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated
"§2851." subsection 1, 2nd paragraph, by inserting at the end,
before the period, the following: 'except that this license
may be issued without fencing or enclosing land in the case of
islands used to propagate wild birds and animals '

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides flexibility to the Department of
Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in issuing permits to allow persons
to raise wild birds and animals on islands without any need for
fencing the birds or animals in.
