SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 270, L.D. 344, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Licenses Issued by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife."

Amend the bill in section 4, in that part designated "§2851." subsection 1, by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

← 'The commissioner may issue a license at an annual fee of \$15 to any person, firm or corporation permitting the licensee to breed, rear or keep wild birds or animals. The licensee shall establish to the satisfaction of the commissioner that he has sufficient land and facilities for the proper care of the wild birds or animals, and that the wild birds or animals can be sufficiently controlled and isolated from natural populations.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides flexibility to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in issuing permits to allow persons to raise wild birds and animals on islands and other isolated areas without any need for fencing them in.
