HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 272, L.D. 346, Bill, "AN ACT to Lower the Daily Limit for Smelt Dealers to 4 Quarts."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Lower the Daily Limit for Smelt Dealers to 6 Quarts.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §2558-A, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 245, is amended to read:
The daily limit for dealers licensed under this section shall be 8 6 quarts and they may possess more than 8 6 quarts provided the taking was legal.'

Statement of Fact

This bill lowers the daily limit for smelt dealers from 8 to 6 quarts.
