COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 153, L.D. 369, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Plumbing Inspectors."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following: \$3224. Approving own work forbidden

No inspector of plumbing may inspect or approve any plumbing work, or installation of a subsurface disposal system, done by himself, or by any person by whom he is or who is employed by or with him. Any inspector of plumbing who inspects or approves his own work commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture/not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.'
