IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Repeal the License Requirement for Taking Certain Clams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6001, sub-§ 41, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, § 5, is amended to read:

41. Shellfish. "Shellfish" means soft-shell clams, quahogs, oysters and mussels and includes shellstock and shucked shellfish.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the licensing requirements for taking "hen" or "storm" clams. This extension of the licensing was done in the revision bill last year.
