STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Reimburse Municipalities for Expenses Incurred in Enforcing Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations Relating to the Operation or use of Motor Vehicles, Streets and Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

4 MRSA § 163, sub-§ 1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Municipal reimbursements. The Treasurer of State shall reimburse any municipality which initiates the proceeding, 50% of fines and costs recovered from any violation of a statute, ordinance or regulation relating to the operation or use of motor vehicles and any violation of a statute, ordinance or regulation relating to the use of streets and highways by pedestrians or by the operation or use of any other vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to recover expenses incurred by municipalities in the enforcement of statutes, ordinances or regulations relating to the operation or use of motor vehicles, streets and highways.
