COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 322, L.D. 423, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require Public Disclosure of Certain Financial
Information by Large Public Utilities."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the first underlined
paragraph of that part designated "§106." of Title 35
and inserting in its place the following:

'Each public utility incorporated in this State and serving
more than 25,000 customers and the New England Telephone
and Telegraph Company shall, within 14 days after the issue
of its annual report, cause to be published in the 5 largest
daily newspapers of this State the following:'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection
2 of that part designated "§106." of Title 35 and inserting
in its place the following:

'2. Payment to lobbyists. A listing of all compensation
paid to lobbyists employed by the utility during the period
covered by the annual report in accordance with Title 3,
chapter 15; and'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company in the requirement of public disclosure of certain financial information by large public utilities and to correct a misspelling.
