COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 323, L.D. 424, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide that the Adoption of Rules by the State
Controller are Consistent with the Maine Administrative
Procedure Act."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'13. Travel expense reimbursement. The State Controller, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may adopt,-modify-or-abrogate-rules-and-regulations establish policies for travel expense reimbursement and carrying out this chapter. Those policies determining which expenses shall be reimbursable and levels of reimbursement shall be deemed rules, and shall be adopted, modified and repealed only in accordance with procedures set forth in the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will provide notice and an opportunity for public hearing when the State Controller establishes which expenses are reimbursable and the level of reimbursement.
