Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th line  
and inserting in its place the following:

'§439. Attorneys'

Further amend the amendment in the last paragraph by striking out  
all of the 2nd line and inserting in its place the following:

'for a residential mortgage loan for one to 4 residential units  
and which requires that an'


Further amend the amendment in the last paragraph by striking  
out at the beginning of the 5th line the following word: "title"

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to limit the application of  
the bill to single family residences and buildings which contain  
no more than 4 residential units. The amendment also removes the  
limiting word "title" before the word "attorney."
